

Leaf Pickup Policy

The City of Gillett offers leaf pickup services during the months of October and November.

Residents may place leaves out at the curb and the city crew will pick them up and dispose of them.

Leaves must be piled on the terrace but not in the curb or street, leaves must not block any part of a sidewalk. If there is not a terrace leaves must be piled as close to the roadway as possible without creating a hazard. Leaves that are piled more than eight feet from the edge of the roadway will not be picked up.

Where ever possible leaves should not be piled within two feet of trees, poles, signs, mailboxes, or other obstructions.

The City will not pickup leaves that have stones or brush in them.

The city will not pick up brush during leaf pickup.


A schedule of leaf pickup dates is available at City Hall and is also on the recycling calendar.
