NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on MONDAY, December 4, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Gillett Municipal Building, a Public Hearing on the Road Project for Birch Avenue for the City of Gillett will be held.

1. Roadways will be closed between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. each day. Access to your property may or may not be available during these times but will be restored by 6 p.m. each night.
2. For the duration of the project, the roadway asphalt will be removed and the roadway maintained as dirt and/or gravel.
3. Existing curb and gutter and sidewalk will be removed and new installed.
4. New water main, sanitary sewer, and storm sewer will be constructed within the roadway.
5. Temporary water disconnections will occur in order to construct new water mains. You will be given a minimum of 24 hours prior notice of any water disconnections. Service interruptions will last no longer than 4 hours.
6. If you have a mailbox, these will be relocated or temporary mailboxes will be set up for the duration of the project. A location for temporary mailboxes will be determined prior to beginning construction.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Who pays for sidewalk replacement? City does.

We are responsible up to the curb stop and utility will be replaced during construction.

Lawn restoration will be done.

Estimated costs of replacing lateral, 30-35 dollars a foot

Advantage of having lateral replaced, would prevent a sewer backup in years to come, cheaper at this time to replace because equipment is here and ground is opened up. Lawn restoration would be home owner if home owners request for this to be done.

Temporary water service will be provided while water lines are being replaced. Replacing storm sewer lines and adding catches, curb and gutter will be replaced, sidewalks replaced.

Garbage could start early for garbage and recycle pickup and pick up before road construction starts each day 6:15 am. Approximately 3 months of construction.
