

Nicolet Trail Campground Rules & Regulations

We would like to maintain a campground that all campers, including the surrounding community, can be proud of. To insure this, your cooperation is necessary. The rules and regulations stated below are for all campers to adhere to during the period of stay approved on your application permit. Violations to the rules and regulations listed below could result in the revocation of your permit and the eviction from the campground without a refund.

The Nicolet Trail Campground Rules & Regulations are as follows:

1. Your site must be kept clean and orderly. *Littering prohibited.* No person shall litter, dump or deposit any rubbish, refuse, earth or other material in the campground.
2. Nothing will infringe onto a neighboring site (parked vehicles, stacks of wood, satellite dishes, etc).
3. There shall not be more than one unit allowed per site.
4. The number of people on your site cannot exceed the occupancy of the camper itself.
5. Only two vehicles are allowed per site and all recreational vehicles and cars must be parked on assigned sites. Additional parking and visitor parking is located in the city park.
6. Screen tents are permissible for eating purposes only and be no larger than 12'x12' in size.
7. Portable decks are allowed and be no larger than 12'x 6' in size.
8. Outdoor carpets and mats must be staked down with stakes no longer than 12 inches. All must be removed at the end of your camping period.
9. No stakes over 12" in length are allowed. You will be held responsible for any damage/cost incurred to underground utilities.
10. Satellite dishes are allowed only if attached to the trailer/camper or on a portable stand. Inground posts are not allowed.
11. All hoses, cords, wires, etc., will be run under the camper or carpets/mats for safety and ease of grass cutting.
12. You are responsible for the care and maintenance of your site by use of your own personal push mower if Seasonal. Riding mowers are not allowed.
13. Each site will consist of one picnic table and one firepit. Neither shall be moved off the site nor any moved in from another site.
14. DO NOT use charcoal grills on picnic tables or benches.
15. No trees will be cut, trimmed or damaged. Defacing, altering or damaging any campground property could result in a fine or even eviction from the campground.
16. Pets are allowed. No more than two pets per site. Pets must be on a leash at all times, no longer than 6ft in length. No pets will be left unattended outside. Pets must be cleaned up after immediately, day or night. Do not allow pets to dig holes. Damages must be repaired or fines will incur.
17. No noisy, intoxicated or disorderly persons or loud parties shall be allowed in the campground. Quiet hours must be observed from 10 P.M. to 7 A.M.

18. All firewood should be stacked in neat piles no more than 4' x 4' high.
19. All garbage must be put in clear plastic bags and be placed in the proper dumpsters provided. Recyclables must be separated and deposited into the proper recycling bins provided.
20. No outside refrigerators allowed.
21. No generators allowed.
22. No party lights will be left on or come on automatically if you are gone for more than two days at a time.
23. All drains on trailers/campers must be kept capped at all times. No discharge or dumping of grey water or sewage on ground is allowed in campground.
24. No washing vehicles, ATV's, UTV's, or motorized vehicles of any kind in the campground.
25. No Hot Tubs allowed in the campground.
26. Pools allowed 100 gallons or UNDER.
27. *Making of fires.* No person shall start, tend or maintain a fire except in personal grills or designated fire rings. Personal grills shall be used only in designated campsites. The use of personal grills is permitted provided lawns and vegetation are not endangered. Unburned fuel and ashes shall be disposed of in such a manner as to prevent fire or damage to any campground property.
28. *****Motorized vehicles.* Except for authorized maintenance vehicles, no person shall operate an unlicensed or licensed motorized vehicle outside of areas specifically designated as parking areas or areas where the operation of such vehicles is specifically permitted. Motor vehicles are restricted to the roads and drives and parking areas. No motor vehicles of any nature may be used on the seeded areas except vehicles which have Chief of Police authorization for shows, rides or exhibits and then only for the purpose of loading and unloading.
29. *Reckless driving in the campground prohibited.* No person shall operate a motor vehicle in a reckless manner in the campground in the City of Gillett.
30. *Removing tree protectors.* No person shall remove any device for the protection of trees or shrubs.
31. No digging in the campground.
32. *Fees and charges.* The Common Council, upon the recommendation of the Community Development Authority Committee, shall have the authority to establish such fees as deemed necessary for use of the grounds. It shall be unlawful to use such areas without payment of such fee or charge when required.\
33. ****Controlled substances.* Possessing, using or dispensing of a controlled substance in violation of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act is prohibited in all City parks.
34. *Ejected from campground for disorderly behavior.* The Police Officers may eject any patron from the campground for any disorderly behavior.
35. *Age restrictions.* Individuals age 17 and under may be in the campground overnight only when accompanied by an adult who is registered at the campground office.
36. *Quiet hours.* Quiet hours are designated to be between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. within the confines of the campground area.
