RETAINER AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT made effective June 25, 2020, between the City of Gillett, a municipal corporation, acting by and through its duly authorized officers, and located in the County of Oconto, State of Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "City", and Hanaway Ross, S.C., by Attorneys Christina Peterson and Clarence Duchac, of 345 S. Jefferson Street, Green Bay, County of Brown, State of Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "Attorney".

SECTION I. NATURE OF ENGAGEMENT

The City hereby retains and engages, pursuant to the authority conferred by it and its duly authorized officers according to Chapter 61, Wis. Stats., and its general police powers, said Hanaway Ross, S.C. and Attorneys Christina Peterson and Clarence Duchac, to render to the City and its duly authorized officers legal advice and to represent the City in code enforcement issues and to act as municipal prosecutors for the Gillett Municipal Court, and other legal services as the City or any of its duly authorized officers may request or require from time to time.

SECTION II. ACCEPTANCE OF ENGAGEMENT

Attorneys hereby accepts the retainer and engagement and promises and will render to the best of their ability the services described herein during the continuance of this Agreement.

SECTION III. TERM

This Agreement is for a term of six (6) months and shall be effective until December 31, 2020. The City shall have the option to extend this Agreement for up to two (2) additional one (1) year terms by sending Attorneys written notice of election of option at least sixty (30) days prior to the end of the then existing term of this Agreement.

SECTION IV. COMPENSATION

As compensation in full for all services to be rendered by any Attorney of Hanaway Ross, the City shall pay to Hanaway Ross the sum of One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per hour. Paralegal time shall be billed at the rate of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) per hour. It is understood that the hourly time charges include, but are not limited to, attendance at meetings, pre-trials, court appearances, telephone conferences, office conferences, legal research, travel, depositions, review of file materials and documents sent and received, preparation for hearings and conferences, drafting of pleadings or instruments and office memorandums and correspondence. Monthly billings will be submitted and will itemize the services performed and the time spent and shall be due and payable upon receipt unless otherwise stated.

The City agrees to assume and pay for all out-of-pocket disbursements incurred and authorized in connection with the Attorney's representation of the City which shall include, but not be limited to, publication fees, filing fees, witness fees, travel expenses, sheriff's fees, expenses of depositions, investigative expenses and other incidental expenses.
