2. Discussion and Possible Action on Washington Street/Bridge

Green Bay Ave. and Washington St. project including the bridge, opinion is included in the packet. Concrete Bridge looks to be best option, \$23,000 more is the difference. Grant money would pay for bridge repair. Estimated to be total project costs of \$306,000. Options are between aluminum or concrete for the bridge structure. Bridge there now is 75 years. Will get an Engineering cost estimate.

Motion to approve the alternative #2 in the packet from Ayres and Associates, the concrete span culvert for the Washington Street Bridge.

Discussion on the entire Washington Street and Green Bay Avenue project, including the bridge, Estimated bridge cost 300,000, road cost includes curb and gutter 402,944, storm sewer 199,200, engineering 228,081.60, total cost \$902,144.00

3. Discussion and Possible Action on taking out cul-de-sac circle in Ridgewood -

Putting stone in would be \$5-6,000, take out grass and add stone, if we take out the circle and add asphalt it is about \$13,000, not including our labor to tear out the curb and grass. Motion went to council to just remove the grass and failed. Council felt that would not fix the problem and needed to be discussed again.
